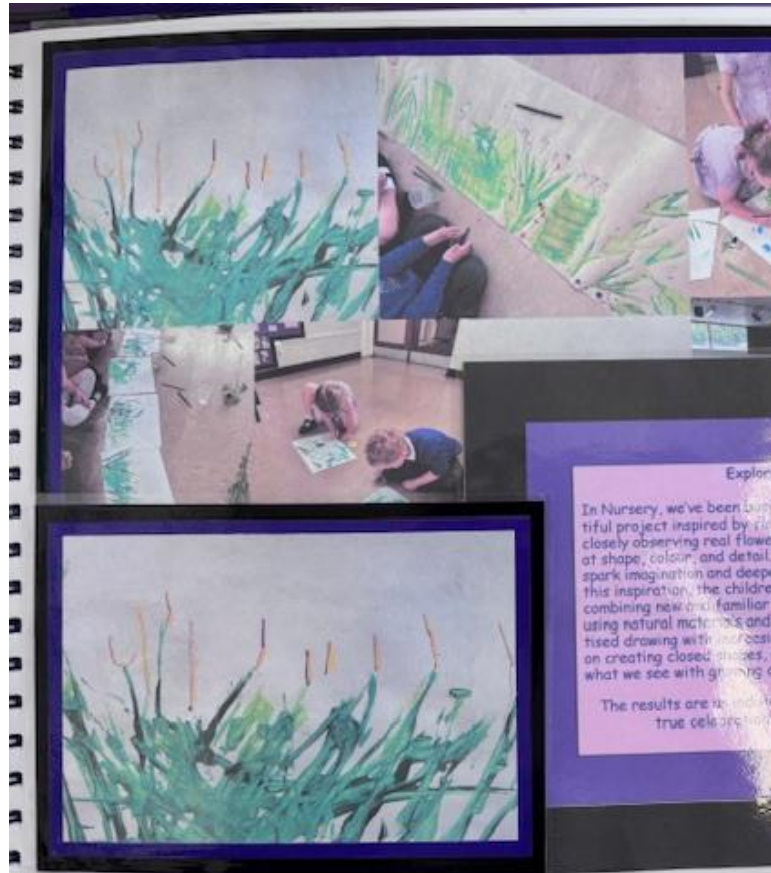


# Access Art Week 2025: Flourish

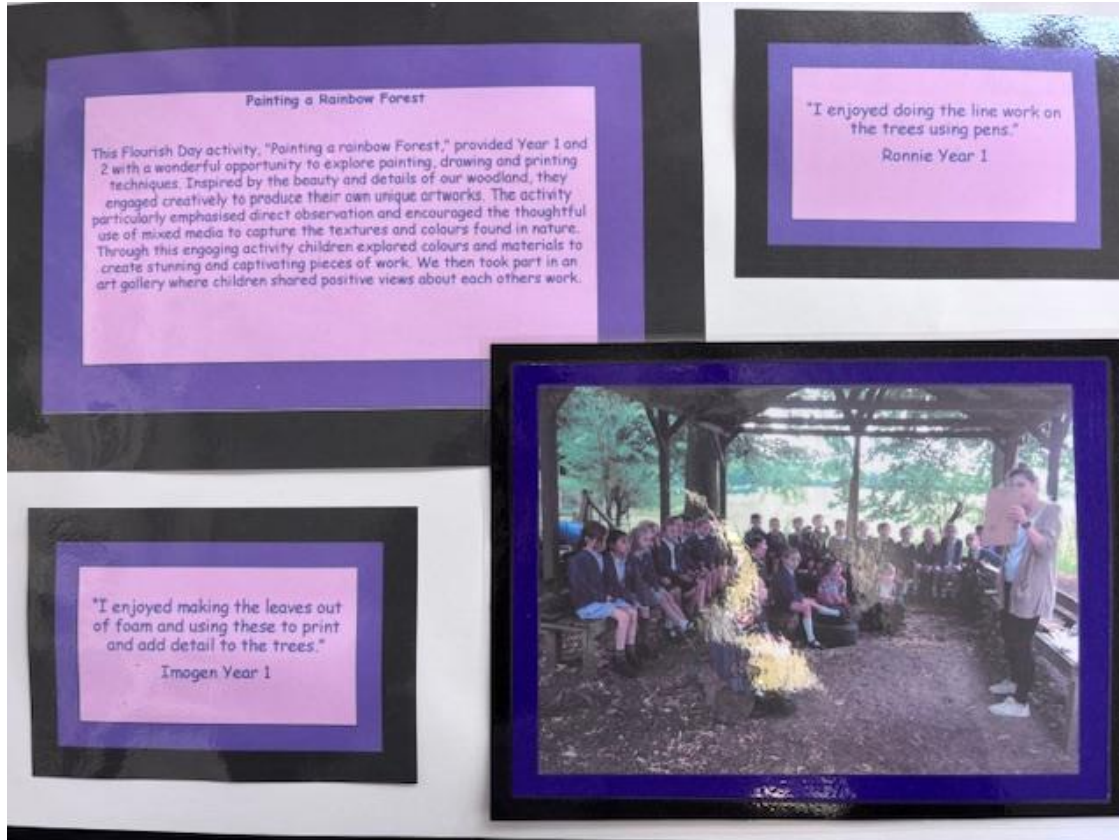


## Exploring Flowers and Meadows

In Nursery, we've been busy developing our artistic skills through a beautiful project inspired by flowers and meadows. The children began by closely observing real flowers in our nursery environment, looking carefully at shape, colour, and detail. We also explored videos of wild meadows to spark imagination and deepen understanding of the natural world. Using this inspiration, the children created their own flower meadow artwork, combining new and familiar techniques. They experimented with printing, using natural materials and tools to create texture and pattern, and practised drawing with increasing control and complexity. We focused on creating closed shapes, adding detail, and exploring how to represent what we see with growing confidence.

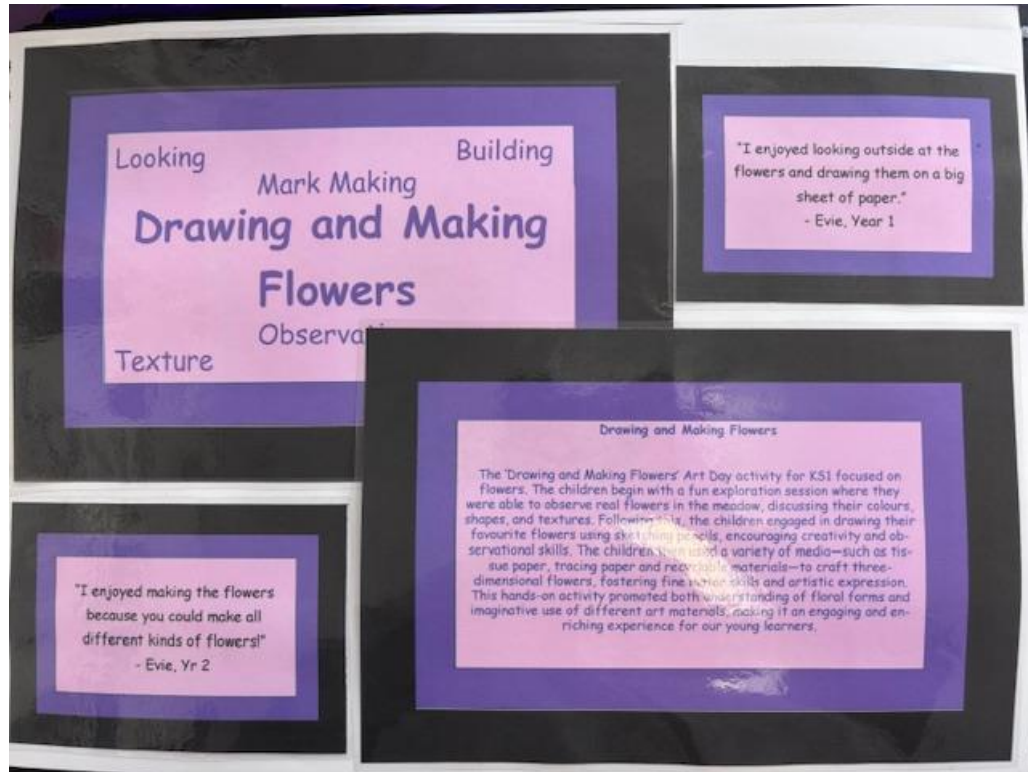
The results are so individual and vibrant as the children themselves - a true celebration of creativity, observation, and growth!

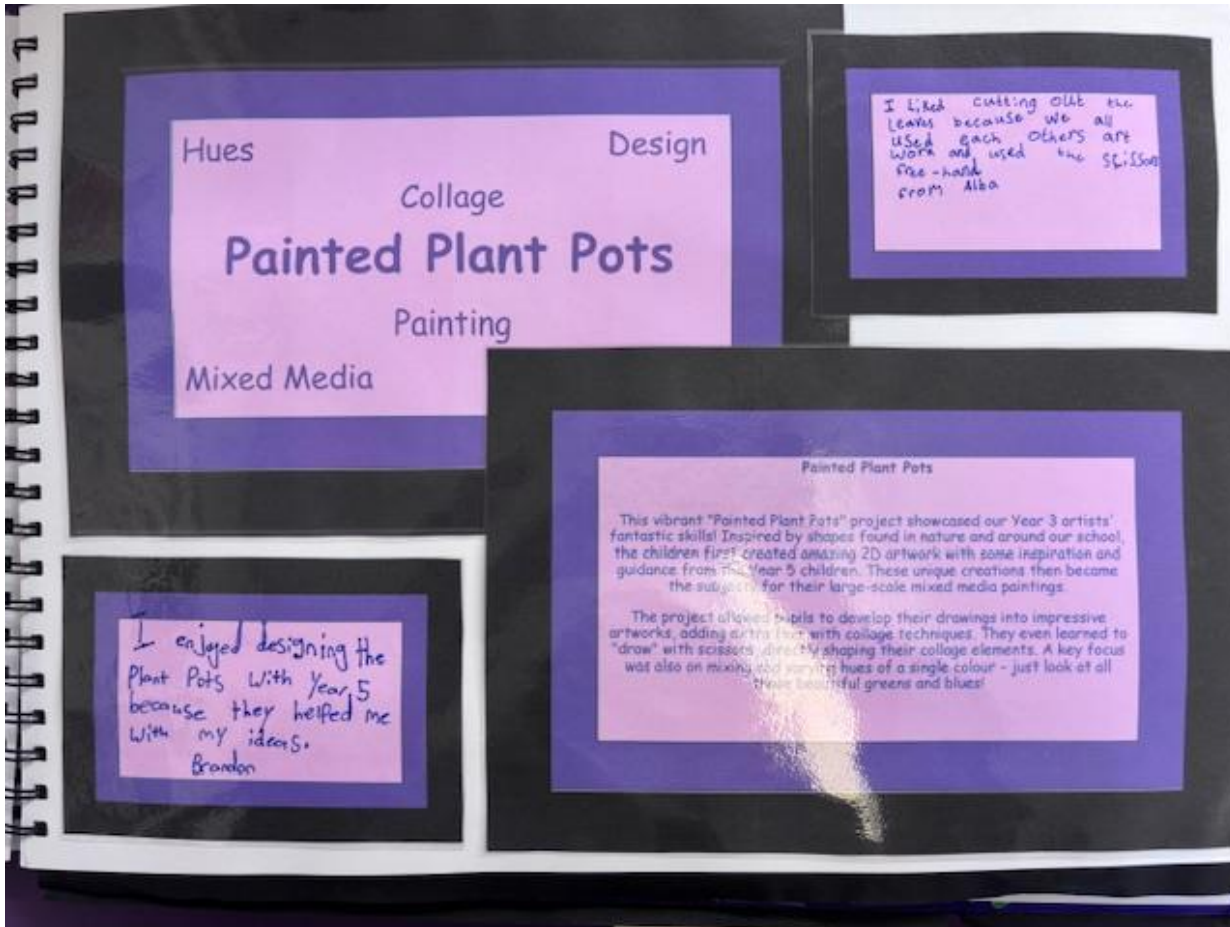

## Year 2

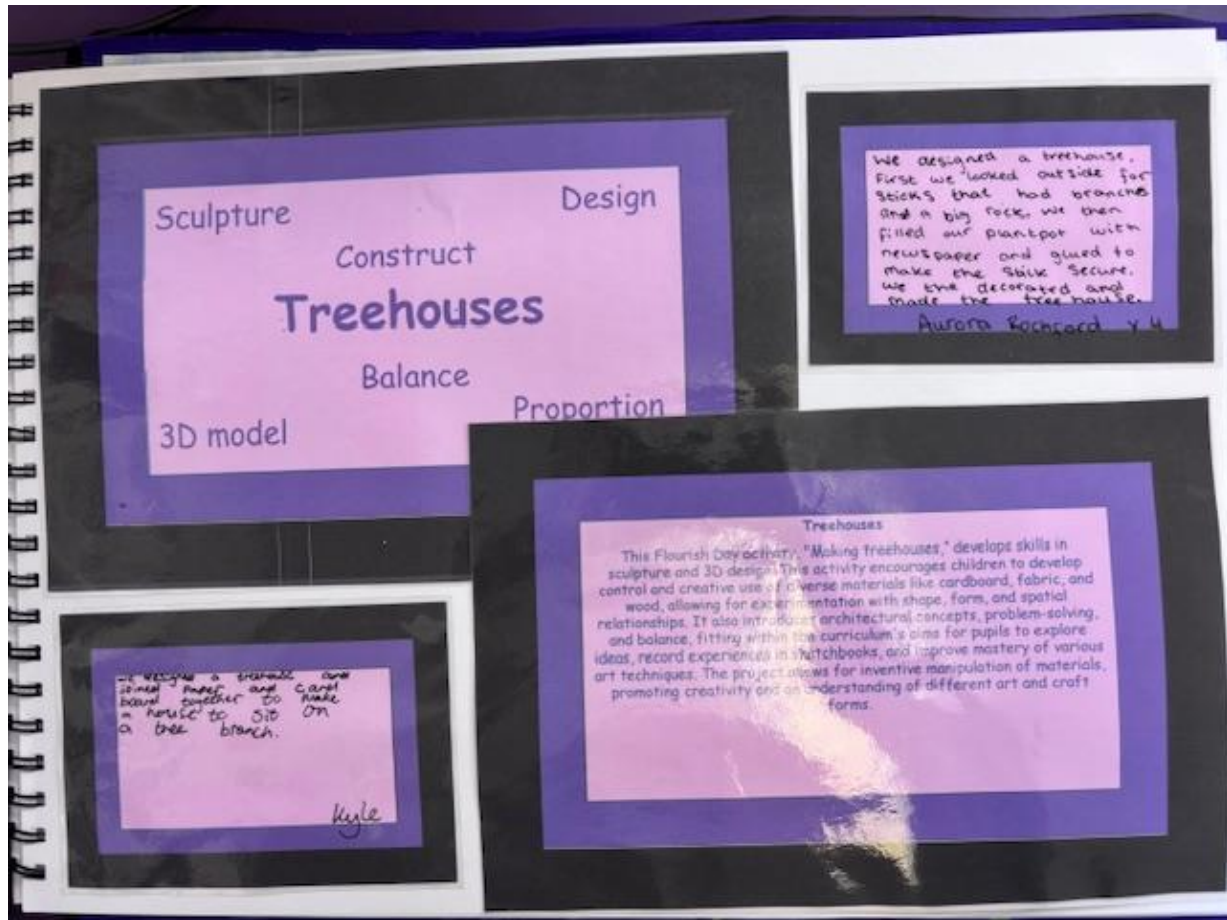

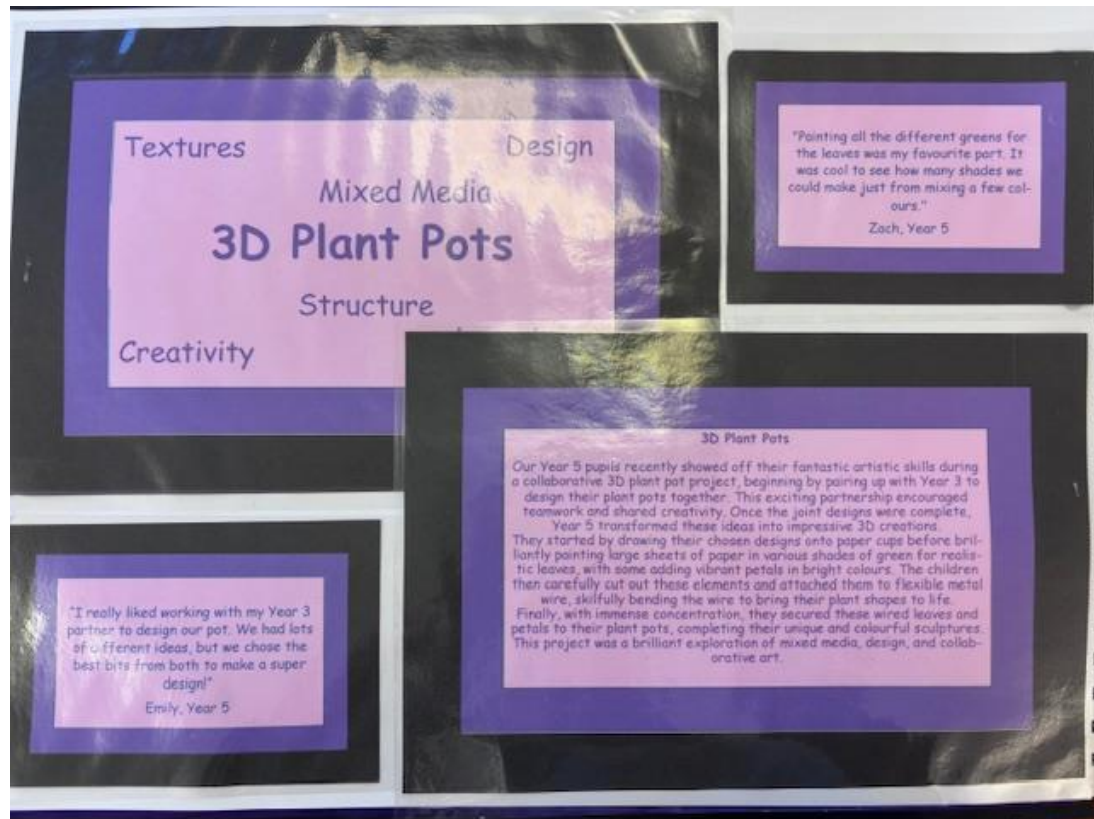
