

Term	Topics
Autumn 1	<u>Why is the History of my Locality important?</u> We will be learning all about our local area, as well as the differences between Manchester now and during the Victorian Era!
Autumn 2	<u>Hot and Cold Places.</u> In this Geography unit we will be learning about how temperatures around the world differ in relation to the equator and how this affects life.
Spring 1	<u>Travel & Transport.</u> We will learn about different types of transport and the history of the wheel. We will look at the difference between early and modern transport and how they have changed over time.
Spring 2	<u>The Geography of Kampong Ayer.</u> In this History topic we will learn about the differences between our lives and the lives of others in small diverse communities, developing Geographical concepts.
Summer 1	<u>Who is Sappho? (Pompeii)</u> We will explore the nature of evidence, as well as cause and effect through exploring a number of key historical concepts. We will also think about how Historians and Archaeologists go about obtaining evidence.
Summer 2	<u>Comparing Countries of the UK.</u> We will learn about the countries of the UK, identifying and describing them. We will also learn about key features of capital cities and how they differ.

Each half term we will send home our Year Two Knowledge Organisers which will provide you with more details about the next topic that the children will be learning about in school.

It will also outline a homework project for you and your child to complete together if you desire.

This will allow them to explore and gain an insight into the work that we will be doing in class each half term.
