Homework


Your homework days will remain the same and you will receive spellings, times tables, English and Maths. You will be tested on your spellings and times tables each Friday.

What will be different?



Some things will change when you move into KS2

<u>Year 3/4 door</u>—You come in and go out through the Year 3 door on the right hand side of school. Remember if you cannot see an adult please come back to Year 3 and we can help you.

<u>Before school</u>— You will come into the playground and line up once the bell has rung.

<u>After School</u> - You will leave school yourself and meet your adult in the playground next to the Year 3 classroom. Your teacher will be there if you cannot find your adult.

<u>Playtime</u>— Morning break will be at the later time of 10.45. There is no break in the afternoon.

<u>Dinnertime</u>—Dinner time begins at 12.10. Children will go into the yard at this time for a short play before eating at 12:20. Children will go back out to play once they have finished eating. <u>Snacks</u>—You will no longer have fruit at school so you may bring your own healthy snack if you wish.

<u>**Phonics</u>**—You will no longer do direct phonics sessions, but you will continue to take part in activities where these skills are reinforced.</u>
